

Statement by Ms. Sasha Dixon, Counsellor Permanent Mission of The Bahamas to the United Nations Office and other International Organizations in Geneva at the 45th Session of the Universal Periodic Review Working Group

Presentation of National Report by the Government of Nigeria

23 January 2024

Thank you, Madam/Mr. [Vice] President.

We welcome the delegation of Nigeria and thank the country for its comprehensive report, prepared through an inclusive national process.

The Bahamas respectfully makes the following recommendations to Nigeria:

- (i) Accelerate efforts toward eradication of female genital mutilation, including through increased public education and awareness-raising campaigns;
- (ii) allocate sufficient resources for the full implementation of the National Action Plan on Human Trafficking (2022–2026);

and

(iii) fully implement the revised National Social Protection Policy as a step toward development of a strong, inclusive and reliable social protection system

We commend Nigeria for progress made since the last review, such as efforts to improve access to quality education, including for out-of-school children; efforts to promote the empowerment of women and girls and steps toward the transition to a low-carbon, climate-resilient economy.

We wish the delegation every success in this UPR process.
